

PATHFINDER LEADERSHIP AWARD

The new program for Pathfinder Leadership Award (PLA) was introduced in our conference last year. The process is detailed and attendees are required to work hard to earn their Award. However, the skills and level of understanding they receive about Pathfinder Leadership at the end of the course is well worth the effort. There are 3 weekends set aside throughout the year where specific modules are taught. They are:

If any person misses a module they can pick up that module in the following year as the course is duplicated every year. The process the Youth Department will follow relating to course work for PLA is:-

1. The resource material and review booklet for each module covered is sent to those applicants who plan to attend the PLA weekend.
2. The attendee will read through the resource material and complete the review booklet.
3. The attendee will bring their resource material and COMPLETED review booklet to the PLA weekend where our DD team will mark their review booklet. Attendees who do not complete their review booklets are encouraged to attend the following year where the module will be taught again.
4. A short presentation of the module will be given.
5. After the presentation there will be an assessment in the form of a true/false test, short answer or an activity to complete.
6. The assessment will be marked by the DD team.
7. The attendee will be deemed competent or incompetent. If deemed incompetent they are given directions as to what they need to do to complete the module.
